DATA ON THE REMOVAL OF CRANTINE MEASURES AND RESTRICTIONS FOR BUSINESS BY REGIONS OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

Region	Self-isolation mode	Removing quarantine and restrictions on business
Moscow	Extended till May 31	Food retailers, pharmacies, pet shops, delivery, mobile stores, shops with basic necessities, non-stationary points at the subway are still working. The industry and construction are allowed to open since May 12. Clothing and shoe shops, beauty shops, fitness centres and entertainment establishments are not allowed to open. It is obligatory to wear masks and gloves at work, in shops, in public transport, in taxis, otherwise a fine of up to 5 thousand rubles. A minimum distance of 1.5 metres is required. Companies and individual entrepreneurs are required to test at least 10 % of the employees every two weeks. At the beginning of the summer as the quarantine eases, the retail shops and services with small areas will open, then the larger retail stores; and then hotels and restaurants.
Moscow Region	Extended till May 31	The work of the enterprises was limited until May 18. It is obligatory to wear masks and gloves at work, in shops, in public transport, in taxis.
St. Petersburg	Self-isolation mode is in operation	Organizations and individual entrepreneurs are allowed to work since May 12, except those limited by City Government Decree 121. By May 18 or before the opening day, they must adopt a basic security standard. Retail trade (other than essential goods) and personal services were suspended. Masks and gloves are required in public places, in shops, in public transport, in taxis.
Leningrad Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	The industry, construction and agriculture are allowed to work. Restrictions refer up to 27% of enterprises, mainly small and medium-sized businesses, individual entrepreneurs and the service sector. It is considered to ease restrictions for small and medium-sized businesses in selected areas in the nearest future. Clothing stores will be able to open in compliance with the masking regime and Rospotrebnadzor norms.
Belgorod Region	Was relaxed since May 12	Shopping and entertainment centers, fairs and markets are opened since May 12. They cannot work during the weekends. Basic necessities shops can work during the weekends.
Bryansk Region	Extended till May 31	The clothing and shoe repair shops were opened on May 12. Small business like shops with an area less than 100 square meters are the first to leave quarantine.
Vladimir Region	Extended till May 31	Industry and construction have been in operation since the end

		of April. Businesses providing domestic services to the individuals are opened since May12.
Voronezh Region	Extended till announcement of the Governor	The work of public places such as theatres, museums, cinemas, children's playrooms, entertainment centres and leisure centres will be suspended until further notice,
Ivanovo Region	The final decision will be after May26	The industrial enterprises were reopened on May12 in compliance with safety regulations. Shopping centres, fitness centres, pools, entertainment facilities, cinemas, clubs are still closed. It is mandatory to wear masks and gloves in public places, in public transport and in taxis, when in contact with other people.
Kaluga Region	Extended till May 31	Hairdressers, repair shops, dry cleaners, car dealerships, gun shops can be opened. Retail outlets, restaurants (restaurants, cafes, canteens, bars, snacks), malls and restaurants are closed.
Kostroma Region	Relaxed since May 12	Shops were opened on May12. Separate entrance, limited number of visitors, sanitary treatment, masks for customers and sellers. Health regulations and social distance must be observed.
Kursk Region	Extended till May 31	Until 31 May, there are no clubs, discotheques, cinemas, children's playrooms, entertainment facilities, fitness centres, public catering, dentistry, retail and utility (except pharmacies and those who sell essential products and goods. Governor's Order. Since 1 May hairdressing salons and beauty salons, car and car washes, repair shops (shoes and household appliances) can be opened. Only the nearest points are allowed to be used. Others may be opened from 12 May.
Lipetsk Region	Suspended since 13	Self-isolation is mandatory for those entering from regions with severe coronavirus problems, those over 65 years of age and those with chronic diseases.
Orel Region	Extended till May 31	Since 12 May, food trade at markets and fairs, retail with pets, car parts, optics and orthopaedic accessories, garden and garden goods have opened. This does not apply to Bolkhov, Mtshensk and Mtshensky district.
Ryazan Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	
Smolensk Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	On 12 May, restrictions were lifted in the area, such as the operation of shopping malls. However, they were reinstated on 15 May. Cinemas and individual entrepreneurs are now closed. Organizations that can work are now closed. Masking mode is on.
Tambov Region	Regime has been relaxed since May 12	The work of trading facilities of more than 1500 sq. m, except pharmacies, optics, grocery stores, pet sales outlets, points of contact, dry cleaning (only listed activities are allowed in large objects) was limited till May 17. It is regional administration

Tula Region	Extended till May 31	
Yaroslavl Region	Extended till May 31 only for vulnerable groups	
Republic of Karelia	Has been relaxed since May 15	Public transport, retail outlets (except for products, building materials, basic necessities, pharmacies, gas stations, communication points), beauty salons, beauty salons and spas (except for certain health care services), are closed until 25 May.
Komi Republic	Extended till May 14	Organizations and individual entrepreneurs whose activities have been suspended
Arkhangelsk Region	Extended till May 31	Restrictions are fully maintained. Gloves and masks are recommended in public places. Those who returned from other regions are sent to quarantine for 14 days.
Vologda Region	Extended till June 1st, the regime will be tightened after the opening of some companies	All industrial enterprises, including small and medium-sized enterprises, are open from 12 May: 82 % of all small and medium-large organizations in the region will be launched in the near future.
Kaliningrad Region	Suspended since May 12	Self-isolation is maintained for vulnerable groups. Retail shops may operate. Sports organizations and restaurants will be closed before 1 June. Who can work
Murmansk Region	Suspended since May 12	
Novgorod Region	Relaxed since May 12	Since May 19, some restaurants and retail establishments and beauty salons can be opened.
Pskov Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	
Republic of Adygeya	Self-isolation mode is in operation	
Republic of Kalmykia	Extended till May 24	Retail outlets were closed except grocery stores, and mass and entertainment events were cancelled.
Republic of Crimea	Extended till May 31	Since May 12, masking is mandatory.
Krasnodar Territory	Was relaxed on May 23	Non-food shops which provide services and are up to 400 square metres were opened on May 23.
Astrakhan Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	
Volgograd Region	Extended till May 31	There are no retail and catering facilities, no mass or entertainment events.

Rostov Region	Slowly relaxing since May 15	Permanent food fairs have been open since 15 May and workers must obtain permits to move around the city on time. Trade in non-food items (other than malls) will open following the recommendations of Rosvoznadzo from May 18.

Republic of Ingushetia	Extended till the 1st of June	It is planned to lift the restrictions from 1 June. From 12 May it is recommended to wear masks in public places, shops, transport (including taxis).

Karachayevo-Circassian Republic	Self-isolation mode is in operation	
Republic of North Ossetia-Alania	Extended till May 31	Hairdressing salons and nail salons are allowed.
Chechen Republic	Self-isolation mode is in operation	
Stavropol Territory	Extended till May 24	Remote retailing, including delivery, is permitted. From 18 May, unproductive goods shops with a sales area of up to 350 sq. m. and with a separate entrance from the street, but only on the condition that there will be no more than 1 person per 5 sq.m at the same time.

Republic of Mari El	Extended till May 31	
Republic of Mordovia	Self-isolation mode is in operation	There are no restaurants, trade, baths, etc.
Republic of Tatarstan	Cancelled since May 12	Retail outlets, restaurants and entertainment centres are closed. Masks and gloves must be worn in public places and transport, including taxis.
Udmurtian Republic	Is relaxing	Retail non-food shops were opened on May 14 everywhere except Izhevsk and Novyi Township. This applies to the points in the mall. The rule is no more than one person per 4 sq. meters. Shops with an area of no more than 400 sq.m. meters, which have a separate entrance from the street. Since May 18th - further relaxation.
Chuvash Republic	Self-isolation mode is in operation	Only production, construction and individual service enterprises that comply with the necessary safety measures may open.
Perm Territory	Extended till May 25	Beauty shops, repair centres for computers and household appliances, car salons, tailoring and shoe repair workshops,



		unproductive shops with a maximum area of 50 sq. with no more than five customers present at the same time can be opened.
Kirov Region	Relaxed since May 12	Markets and unproductive shops with no more than 400 sq. m, with a separate entrance and with a restriction on the simultaneous presence of buyers are opened since 12th of May. In these places it is obligatory to wear masks and gloves, maintain social distance, disinfect. After 19 May, the next phase of deregulation will begin: up to 800 square metres of commercial property may be opened before 26 May. with unproductive goods, and after a week all enterprises of services and trade, public catering, educational institutions, hotels.
Nizhny Novgorod Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	Restrictions will begin to be lifted at the end of May. The first to open is the service sector, the public catering and the retail of non-food items. Compliance with the requirements of the Ministry of Labour and Social Security is mandatory.
Orenburg Region	Extended till May 31	Since 18 May, markets and malls have been opened with social distance, disinfection, and the prohibition of service to visitors without masks and gloves.
Penza Region	Extended till May 31	All limitations remain.
Samara Region	Extended till May 25	Retail outlets with a commercial area of up to 400 sq. m and a separate entrance are allowed, provided that 4 sq. It will have no more than one visitor.
Saratov Region	Extended till May 31	All limitations remain.
Ulyanovsk Region	Extended till May 15	Official information on business support measures in the region
Kurgan Region	Extended till special announcement of the Governor	Since May 12, all organizations and individual entrepreneurs are allowed to start operating except: catering, shopping malls, solarium, bath, sauna, clubs, discotheques, cinemas and physical culture and sports companies.
Sverdlovsk Region	Extended till May 18	Since May 19 shops and malls opened. Conditions: strict sanitary regulations, limit on the number of visitors at least 10 sq. m per person
Khanty-Mansi-Autonomous Area	Extended till May 31	Organizations prohibited from working
Yamal-Nenets Autonomous Area	Extended till May 31	In accordance with health standards, hairdressing salons, beauty salons and shops with an area of less than 400 sq. m with a separate entrance opened on 12 May.
Tyumen Region	Extended till May 31	From 18 May, the enterprises of trade, trade and entertainment centres, catering enterprises, household services, fitness complexes, other enterprises and individual entrepreneurs were reopened.

Altai Territory	Self-isolation mode is in operation	Hairdressing salons and some non-food shops can operate.
Krasnoyarsk Region	Extended till May 31	There are plans to permit the operation of hairdressing salons, the atelier, parts of the non-food group shops and many other service providers. No exact date yet.
Irkutsk Region	Extended till May 31	The first stage of quarantine removal will restore the operation of the baths, enterprises with household services, unproductive shops with a sales area of up to 400 sq. m and a separate entrance. But the dates have not been set yet.
Kemerovo Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation till May 17	Organizations that can work
Novosibirsk Region	Self-isolation mode is in operation	Since May 12, food markets are allowed to operate, except in Novosibirsk.
Omsk Region	Prolonged till May 24	Since 12 May, car dealerships, clothing and shoe shops have been opened if they are located in separate buildings or in buildings with a separate entrance and an area of not more than 400 sq. meters.
Tomsk Region	Prolonged till June 1st	Organizations that cannot work
Republic of Buryatia	Extended till May 31	The restrictions were completely lifted for all industrial and construction enterprises and partly for unproductive retailing: so far only shops with a floor area of no more than 400 sq. m.
Republic of Sakha	Self-isolation mode is in operation in some cities	The quarantine will be relaxed depending on the nature of the locality. In large cities, first of all, there will be an atelier and a dry cleaner.
Trans-Baikal Territory	Extended till May	Since April, Trans-Baikal Territory has allowed some businesses to work in retail (small shops) and services.
Kamchatka Territory	The restrictions are slowly relaxing since May 12	Hairdressing salons, beauty salons, dry cleaners, clothing and shoe repair facilities may operate with some restrictions.
Primorye Territory	Extended till May 31	
Khabarovsk Territory	Extended till June 1st	In the first stage of the quarantine exit, small unproductive stores can be opened. then small shopping malls with no food stores and playgrounds, with the proviso that buyers can stay within the social distance. The last to be opened are the malls and malls



		with kitchenettes, movie theatres and children's rooms, a public house, public baths and saunas.

Magadan Region	The restrictions are slowly relaxing since May 12	Health-care centres and beauty salons may be opened.
Sakhalin Region	The restrictions are slowly relaxing since May 12	Since May 18 all shopping malls are opened
Jewish Autonomous Area	Extended till May 31	Quarantine mitigation is not yet planned.
Chukotka Autonomous Area	Extended till May 31	Shops and services are allowed to operate in accordance with health standards.
